GOLF CART/ATV,UTV OPERATION AFTER DARK IN LAKE SUMMERSET

The LSA Board of Directors has approved the operation of golf carts and ATV/UTV's after sunset and before sunrise. All LSA Members will have the option whether they would operate their golf carts and ATV/UTV's after dark. If they opt not to, they would just abide by all of the Rules already stated in the Red Book

If an LSA Member chooses to operate their golf cart or ATV/UTV after sunset and before sunrise, they must comply with the following rules, which will become Rule C; 6 (i) of the Red Book:

1. They would need to sign an application that states they will abide by all the rules adopted for operation of the golf carts between sunset and sunrise.
2. Operators between sunset and sunrise must be at least 18 years of age or older with a valid driver's license. LSA Member must accompany guest driver, both must be able to produce valid DL if stopped.
3. Operation between sunset and sunrise is allowed only on LSA owned roads and parking lots.
4. Golf carts and ATV/UTV's must have full light package, including headlights, brake lights, turn signals, emergency lights and a rear view mirror. Vehicles must have reflective lot markers as well as reflective tape on the rear and sides of the vehicle. A reflective flag will also be required. It is strongly recommended that each vehicle carry a flashlight with them at all times when operating after dark.
5. Golf carts of Members who opt in for operation after dark must go through an annual Public Safety inspection for all equipment and display issued sticker for operation between sunset and sunrise.
6. Violation of the rules will result in citations, fines and possible revocation of all golf cart privileges.
